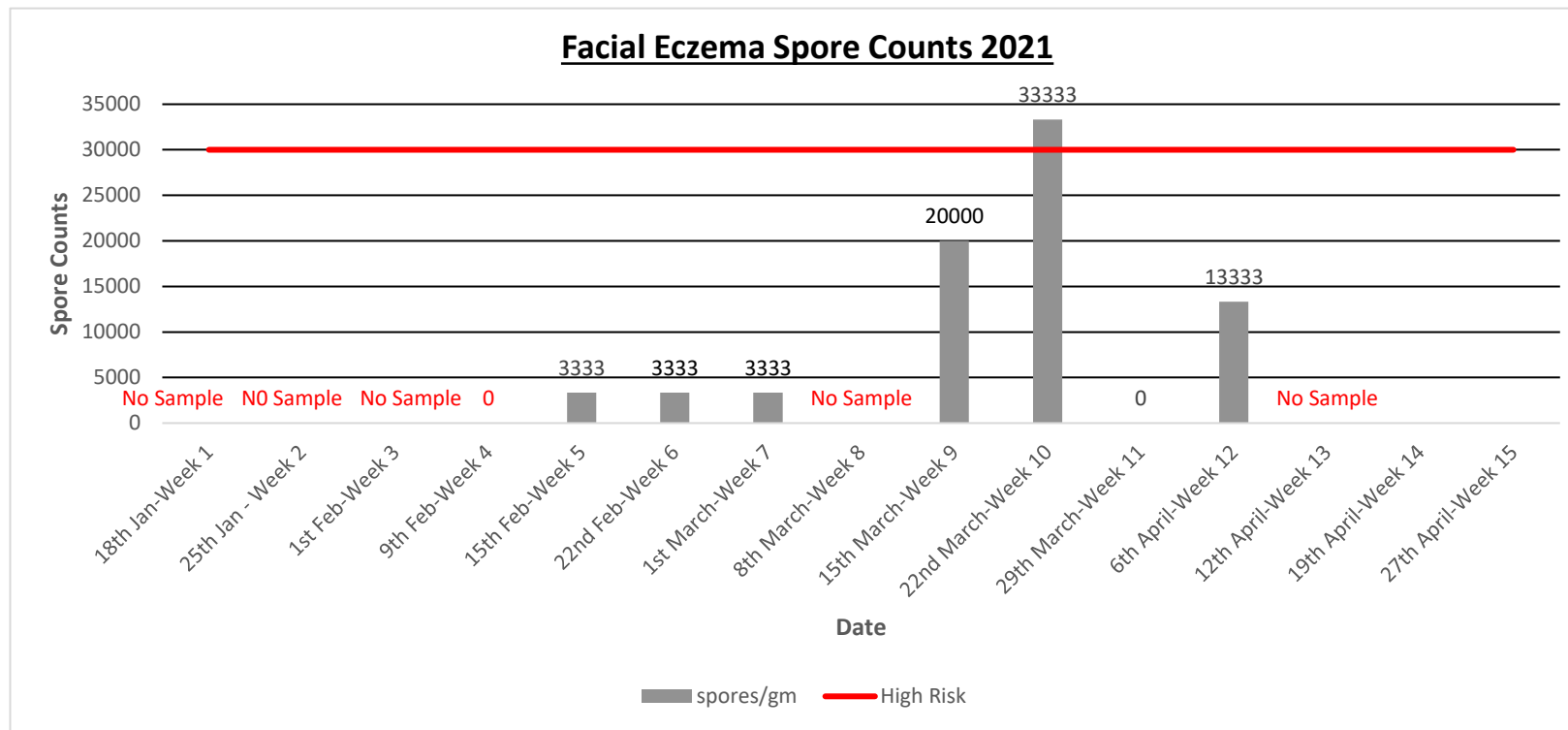




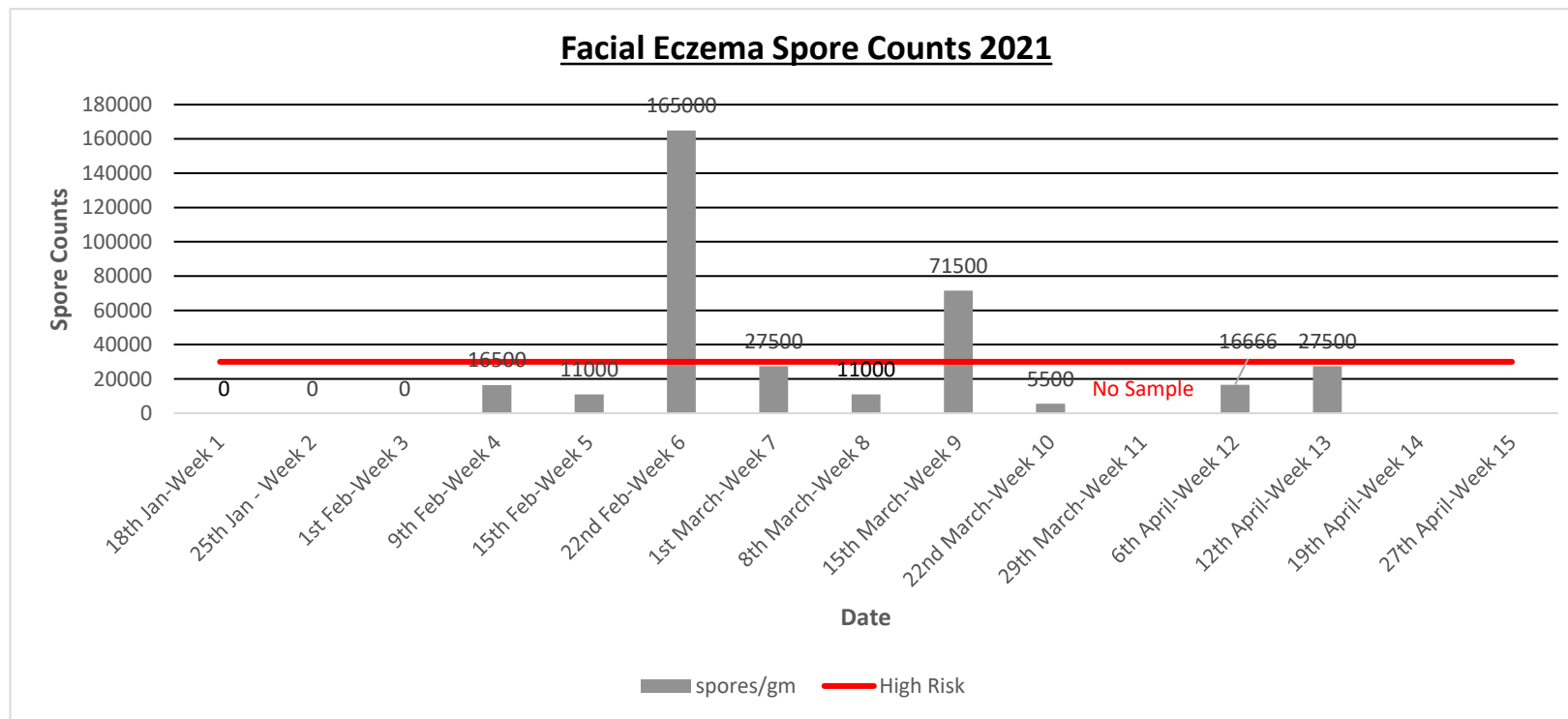
When local pasture spore counts are trending upwards of 20,000 spores / gram and weather conditions look favourable for sporulation, monitor your own farm’s pasture spore counts week to week and implement Facial Eczema control and prevention strategies. As a guide levels over 30,000 spores/gram of pasture will cause toxicity if grazed for over 2 weeks while levels of over 100,000 spores/gram can cause serious liver damage after as little as 3 days.

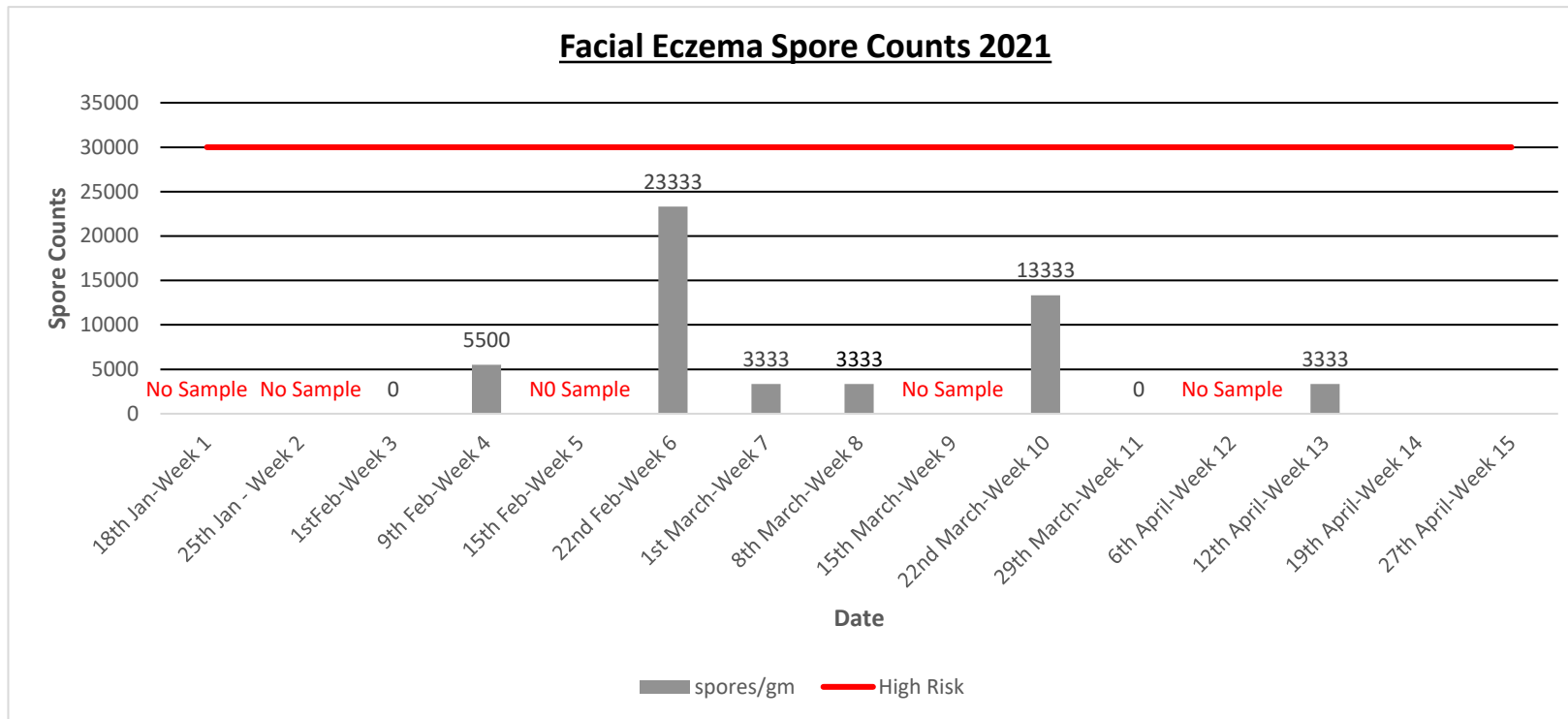

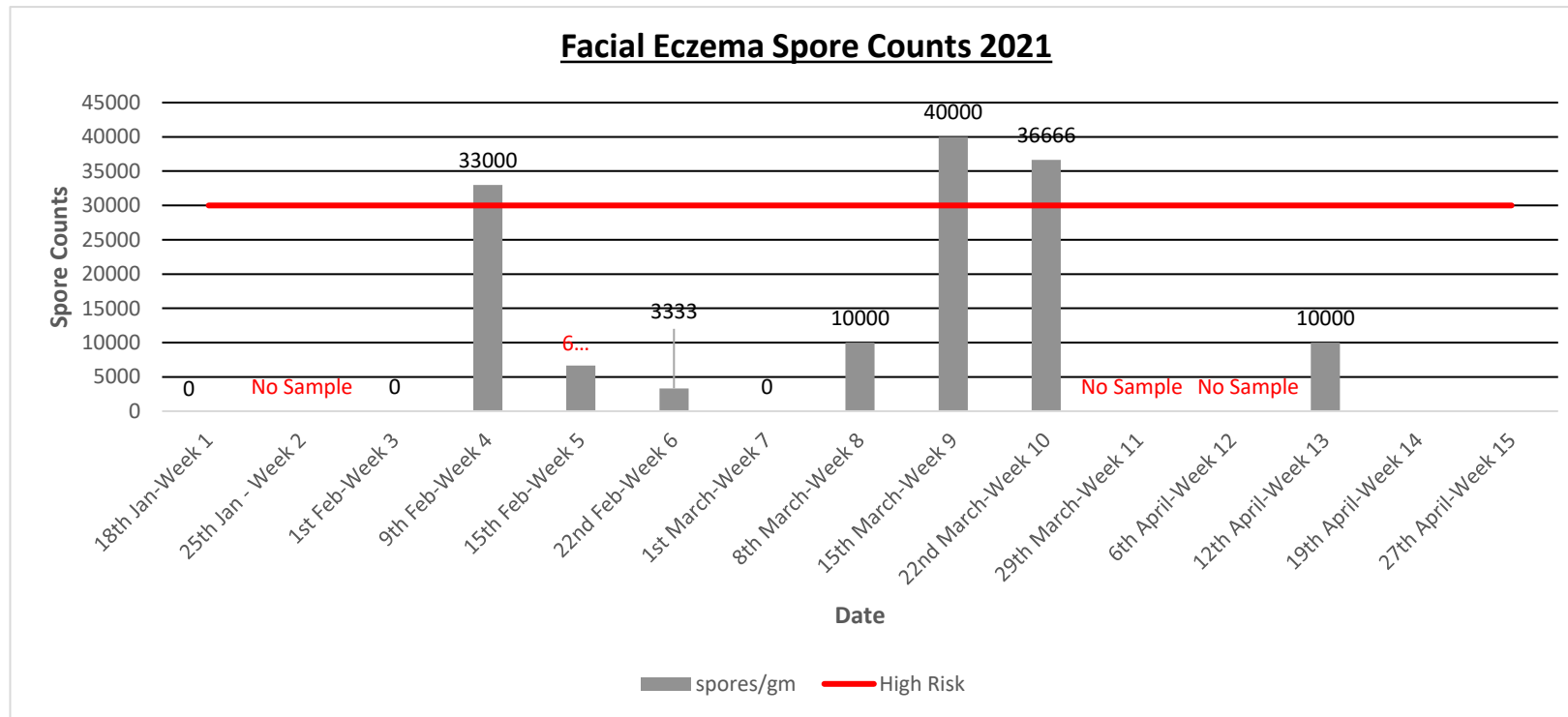
