The Machine

- Prattley 4.2m long sheep conveyor
- Designed to maximise throughput times and reduce labour costs
- Includes own power supply 9HP Honda engine Hydraulic power pack
- Non-slip perforated alloy working platform on both sides
- Fits onto the end of any drenching race
- Process up to 400-650 sheep per hour depending on number of treatments
- Variable speed and adjustable width to process both lambs and bigger ewes
- Ideal for mouthing, vaccinating, drenching, capsuling and applying sheep dip

The Benefits

- Can process sheep more timely and efficiently to reduce labour costs including a reduction in staff fatigue
- Timely and efficient processing of ewes or lambs means less yarding time and less time off grass. This means the potential risk of metabolic issues arising from yarding ewes close to lambing is reduced
- Administer treatments more accurately and safely
- Multiple treatments can be given reducing trips up the drenching race which reduces time and stress to sheep
- Efficient processing of lambs reduces stress, yard time and time off grass too reduce growth rate check
- Light weight, mobile trailer allows the option to process sheep at multiple yards around a property (subject to track access)
